### Open Houses:

The survey will be up and available until March 8<sup>th</sup>.

Cheri asked about the set-up planned for the two town meetings. They will be an Open House format so folks can come and go. Some signage will be up explaining the project and informal visiting with the project contractor and county board members present. The opportunity to take the survey will be available with computers right at the meeting.

**County Website:**

Tony reported that he had visited the Washington County Website. It was created by a 3<sup>rd</sup> party so any modifications to content must conform to the established framework. There were some boards or commissions missing from the website. Dennis C. reminded the commission that information must be submitted in order to be added to the site.


Robert P. said that the survey information will be displayed on the first page of the County Website.
