Minutes:

The minutes from June 6th and July 11th, 2022 needed to be approved at this meeting. Dennis L. moved to approve the minutes and Steve moved to second. Motion carried.

Mitigation Business:

Copies of the Preservation Plan Draft, printed by the County Clerks office (Thank you) were sent around to the membership along with a summary of it written by Sheri. Tony then turned the meeting over to Sheri for an overview of the Plan. She and Barbara have been reworking this draft based on the comments received from this body. It needs to be looked over and get any concerns or typos back to her and she will just reprint those troubled sections. Then it will be ready for public input.

Sheri commented that we’re on schedule for our plan. If we can have this next part finished just after our September meeting, that will be good timing. Barbara doesn’t want to be doing county surveys in the winter weather and snow.

Sheri made the comment that we were very aggressive in our first round many years ago of our Reconnaissance Survey. Barbara suggested that we now choose some of the surveys we’ve already done, and dig deeper doing a more intensive survey.

Get any changes or corrections to Tony ASAP to pass on to Sheri. She would like to make all the changes at once and then will just reprint those pages with corrections on them to slip into our documents for use at our sites for the next step. It should save a lot of unnecessary printing.

Once the correction process is complete, we are ready to present it to the public for their input. We need to decide how long we want to keep the survey open. Locations for the display and comment cards could be libraries, courthouses, Senior Centers, Elks Club... If we want school staff and student input, school begins around August 22nd.

Lisa said that we should choose some sites, have the poster and survey there for a week or so and then keep them moving around.

Tony opened the discussion on how we plan to get this document information to the folks in our county for this survey as well. The majority of the feedback **to our spring survey** came **via** on line. Lisa has a lot of photos ready for the story board ... kinda of a: "Here's what we had – Here's what we've lost – approach.

Dennis C. offered to work up a second flier for the website. Lisa offered to work with Dennis and put together the **displays**. It was suggested that maybe a postcard sized response card to put in a box on the table to allow feedback that would be filled out right there and turned in. It will have to be short, easy to use, quick to make suggestions, or share their own opinion. Tony will drop the poster boards off at Dennis C. tomorrow.

Dave asked if we are clear on what we're wanting as our final product. We need to be realistic. Are we really including the best properties for our county. Dennis said that he felt we're wanting county input on properties that need to be included in our Preservation Plan because they are important to the history and people of the county. Lisa added that it would be kind of a... Here's what we've done... What else do we need to include?

Thel offered to get some photo from the upper county to include on the posters displayed up there.

Tony asked that we work to have it ready for distribution throughout the County by Friday, August 12th. Our job right now is to just get the County Members to let us know if we're including what is important to them and our County as a whole.


Dennis C. said that we need to get this into the hands of our W.C. Commissioners
