

NOTICE

As per Resolution 26-02 adopted by the Board of Washington County Commissioners on 1/12/2026

SOLID WASTE FEES:

Return Check Fee.....A fee of \$20 shall be charged for all returned items

Late Fee for Invoiced Billings after 30 days.....\$25.00 or 18% annually

At non-scaled sites:

Attendants shall use the U.S. EPA’s “Volume-to-Weight Conversion Factors” table for calculating fees.

Construction & Demolition:

- Large Concrete without Re-bar - 860 pounds per cubic yard
- Large Asphalt Paving without Re-bar - 773 pounds per cubic yard
- Composition Roofing -731 pounds per cubic yard
- Clean Dimensional Lumber - 169 pounds per cubic yard
- Gypsum Board - 467 pounds per cubic yard
- Carpet - 147 pounds per cubic yard
- Carpet Padding - 62 pounds per cubic yard

Mixed MSW:

Residential, Institutional, Commercial, Uncompacted - 250 pounds per cubic yard

Scrap Tire:

- Light Duty Tires (passenger, light truck), 22.5 pounds each
- Commercial Tires 120 pounds each

Yard Trimmings:

- Leaves 250 pounds per cubic yard
- Mixed Yard Waste, (grass clippings) Uncompacted 250 pounds per cubic yard
- Prunings, Trimmings, Branches, and Stumps 127 pounds per cubic yard

At scaled sites:

Agricultural Waste as defined per IC 39-7403 (2).....\$30.00 per ton

Antifreeze / Waste Oil Disposal Fee.....\$2.50 per gallon

Road & Bridge sites will no longer accept used oil unless accompanied by an EPA number and shall follow the following recordkeeping requirements.

Before accepting the first shipment, provide each generator, marketer, transporter, or processor/re-refiner a one-time written and signed notice containing the certification requirements specified in 40 CFR 279.66.

Keep a record of each used oil shipment accepted for burning. Records for each shipment must include the following:

- Name, address, and EPA ID number of the transporter who delivered the used oil.

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- Name, address, and if applicable, the EPA ID number of the used oil generator.
- Quantity and acceptance date of the used oil.

The off-specification used oil records must be kept for at least 3 years.

Burn Barrels.....\$10 each

Construction / Demolition Material:

Construction / Demolition as defined per IC 39-7403 (10).....\$60.00 per ton

At non-scaled sites:

Attendants shall use the U.S. EPA's "Volume-to-Weight Conversion Factors" table for calculating fees.

Proof of source must be provided. (Copy of building permit, site address)

Concrete & asphalt*\$60.00 per ton

*If broken to under 8 inches\$30.00 per ton

Concrete containing metal will not be accepted

Asbestos will not be accepted.

No Out of County construction / demolition will be accepted.

Dead Animal Disposal:

Animal parts (processed).....\$30.00 per ton

Horses.....\$75.00 each

Cows over 500 pounds.....\$35.00 each

Any other animal under 500 pounds.....\$20.00 each

Each additional animal under 500 pounds.....\$5.00 each, per visit

Green Waste (grass, leaves, tree limbs, etc.).....\$5.00 per ton

Mattress or Box Spring.....\$5.00 each

Mixed Load (load containing multiple types of waste)\$120.00 per ton

Refrigerator / Air Conditioner.....\$20.00 each

Tires\$400.00 per ton

Uncovered Load Fee (IC 49-613(5), WCC 8-6-1).....\$10.00 Each
